



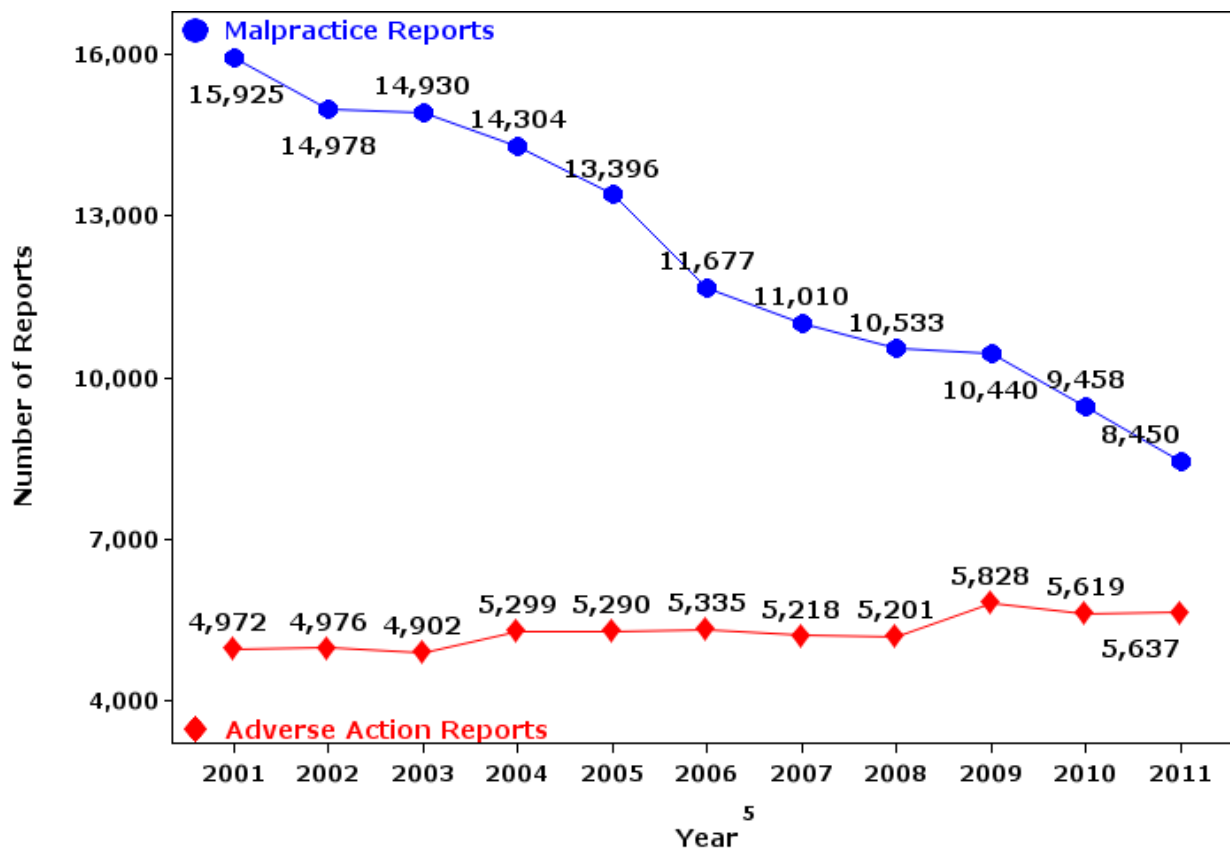

United States - NPDB Report Trend Plots for Physicians

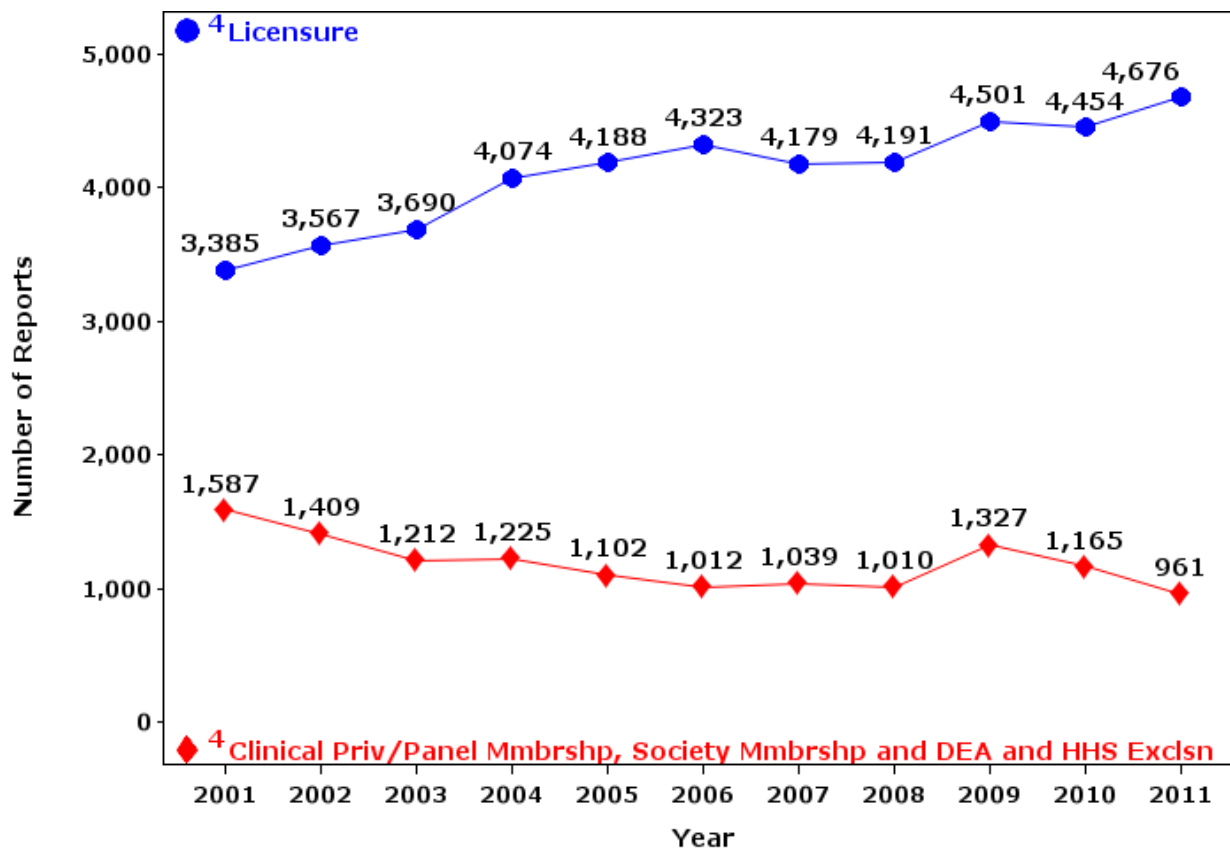
